Other advocacy efforts included meeting with United Nations Delegates, ambassadors, ministers, heads of state, and NGO leaders at over eighty United Nations Missions, at United Nations conferences, as well as meetings within countries.

Participated at and led advocacy efforts at various UN conferences including the Beijing Plus Five Prep Com and Summit-NYC, UN Children's Plus Ten Prep Com(s) and Summit- NYC, Sustainable Development Summit- Johannesburg, South Africa. Initiated and organized an historic UN panel discussion on Family at the United Nations Children's Summit in New York City.

Site visits and assessment through Uganda, Kenya, Mozambique, South Africa, and Swaziland. Facilitated meetings with King of Swaziland and national ministers, and Boy Scouts of America in South Africa, and in Swaziland.
